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Happily ever after is only a **CLICK** away!




Once upon a time, not long ago,

I SHALL go to the BALL!"

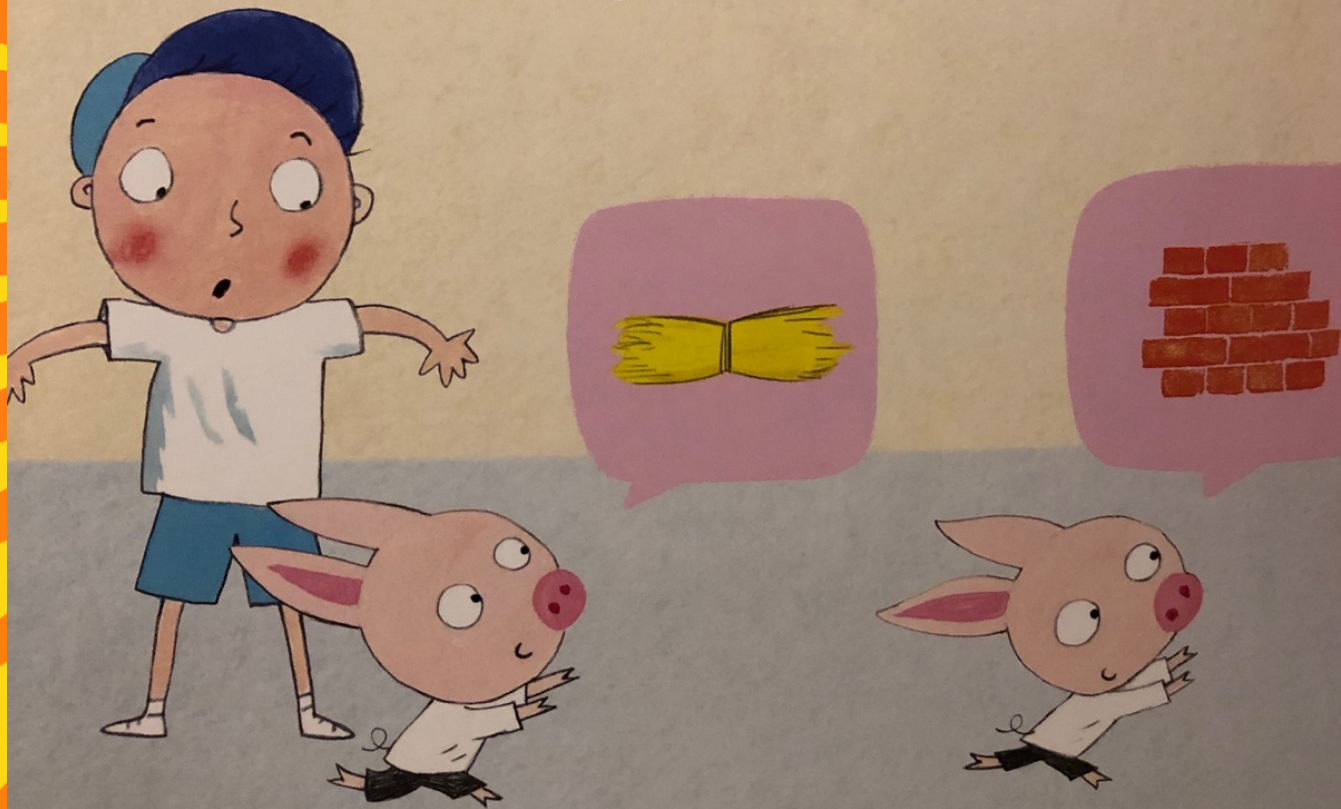

GAMING ONLINE






Do you think the

"HOORAY!"

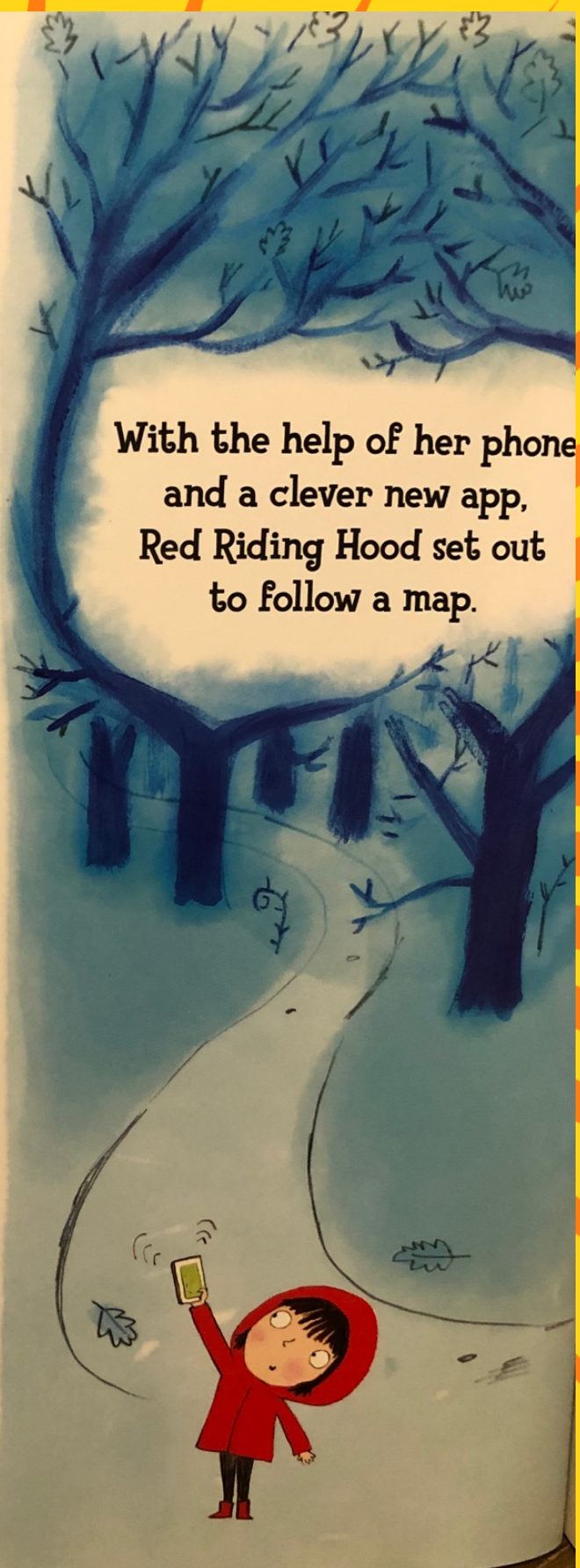
They all cheered,

for over an hour!"




And the Big Bad Wolf

time to have FUN!"



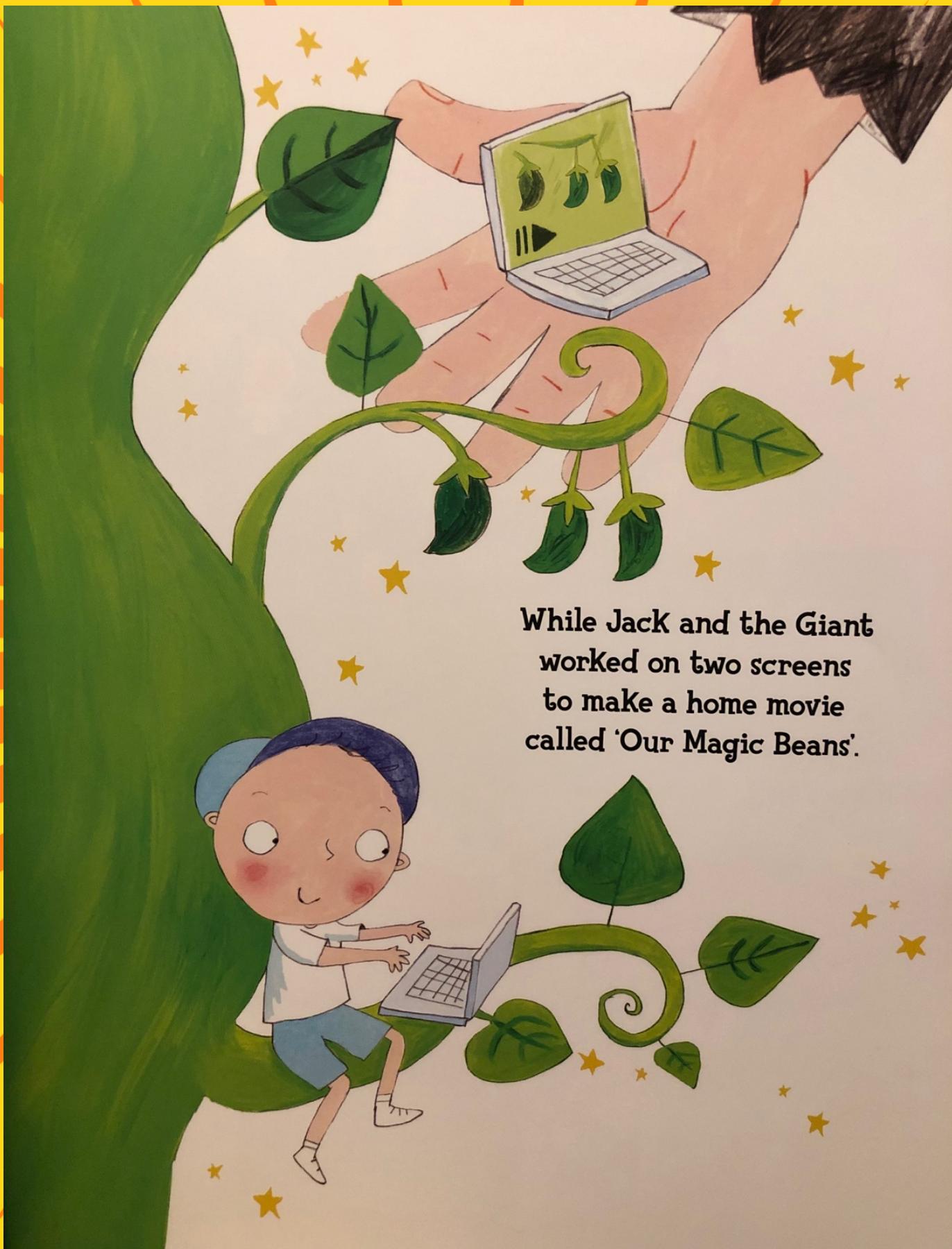
She showed Rapunzel new styles for her hair...

called 'Our Magic Beans'.

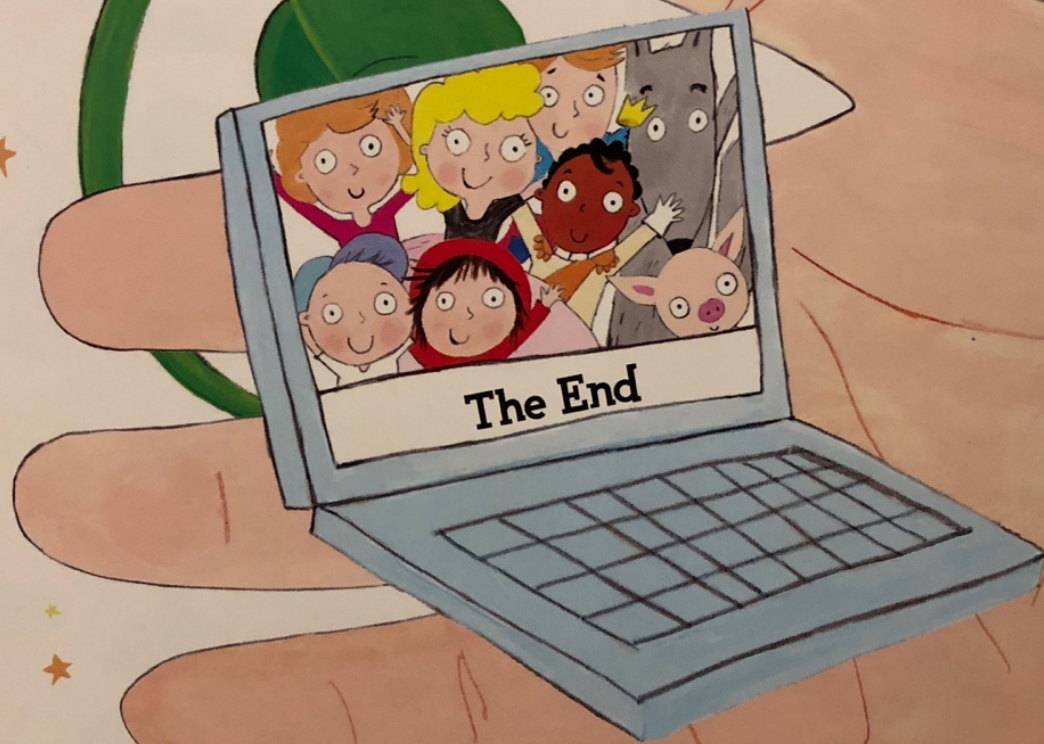
Now, when going online
